

SERGER BUYING GUIDE

Sergers, also known as overlock machines, use multiple thread strands to construct a strong seam that encloses the raw fabric edge, eliminating fraying and the need for an additional seam finish. Serged seams contain more stretch than a conventional sewing machine seam, so sergers come in handy when working with knit or other stretchy fabrics.






Most sergers differ from conventional sewing machines because they have two sets of feed dogs positioned one in front of the other under the throat plate. This allows for a feature called "differential feed," meaning that the two feed dog sets are adjustable to feed the fabric through the machine at different speeds depending on the fabric and seam type.

Which machine is right for you depends on how you intend to use it. Do you plan to finish seams, create special hems or edgings or take advantage of the whole array of serger feet on the market? The following models offer great options and features whether you're looking for a beginner-friendly model or a high-end machine with all the bells and whistles. ⑤
